## Christmas Card Project

With every experience a little different this school year we're pleased to say the children will still be taking part in the **Christmas Card Project** this year, bringing a real sense of pride to the children when they see their artwork in print and raising vital funds for the LSA so please do take part if you can.



You'll be able to order **Christmas cards, gift wrap** and **tags** and for the first time this year, **mugs** with your child's print on - fantastic Christmas gifts for family and friends!

We're using the same provider as previous years however the process is slightly different due to current guidelines.

Your child's artwork will be coming home from school by the **16th October**, along with a leaflet from the printers as to how to make orders - **KEEP THE ARTWORK SAFE**, you'll need to return it to school!

You'll have until 2nd November to **MAKE ORDERS ONLINE**.

You then need to **RETURN THE ARTWORK** to school by the **5th November**.

Without returning it you won't receive any ordered products as the printers won't be able to scan the work (we're still confirming return process but there may be a box outside reception)

You receive the products you ordered and your child's original artwork back via the school (date TBC, expected late November)

(If you don't make any orders there is no need to return the original artwork to school)
